ABOUT US



The history of the old Johannesburg gasworks can be traced back more than one hundred years to 1892 when a 30-metre gas pipeline was first installed in President Street to supply lighting. The gasworks were originally managed by the Johannesburg Council's Department of Water and Gas which operated from the suburb of Cottesloe. Gas was produced at the Cottesloe Gasworks from 1952 until 1991, but in 1992 a decision was taken to cease all production at the Cottesloe Gasworks and purchase gas from Sasol Gas instead.

In August 2000, the Greater Johannesburg Metropolitan Council completed the privatisation of Metro Gas, a South African gas distributor. It was sold to Cottesloe Investment Holdings and resulted in the formation of Egoli Gas (Pty) Ltd on 18 August 2000. In 2010, Reatile Group acquired a 25% shareholding in Egoli Gas through Reatile Energy, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Reatile Group. In July 2013 the remaining 75% shareholding in Egoli Gas was sold to the Reatile Group.





EGOLI GAS TODAY

As a reticulator, Egoli Gas provides natural gas to homes and businesses via underground pipes. We service the Greater Johannesburg metropolitan area, with more than 8,500 customers in domestic, multi-dwelling and central-water-heating precincts, as well as in the hospitality, industrial and power-generation sectors.

Our commitment to an energy-efficient, low-carbon lifestyle ensures that our customers can access an uninterrupted flow of piped natural gas, which is ready to use safely. Our reticulated network is located in many of the well-established Johannesburg suburbs, and in recent years has been extensively expanded into Sandton and Randburg.

NERSA trading licences were obtained in 2013 and 2014 respectively to enable us to trade in Gauteng and KwaZulu-Natal under the auspices of Reatile Gastrade within the Reatile Group. As Egoli Gas we assumed the role of trader within the Reatile Group in February 2019, taking over the rights and obligations of the trading licences from Reatile Gastrade.

We trade natural gas and methane-rich gas outside of the Egoli Gas reticulated licensed area to large industrial customers. Our trading licences for Gauteng and KwaZulu-Natal have enabled us to develop opportunities on existing 3rd party natural gas pipelines within these regions of South Africa.

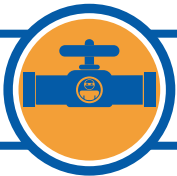

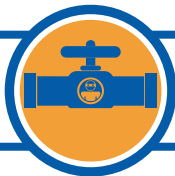
Piped natural gas is cost-effective, instant and safe when used in accordance with prescribed specifications. Because it is lighter than air it dissipates safely into the atmosphere in the event of a leak. Egoli Gas is consistent in quality, clean, affordable and reliable as well as safe to use gas.

WHY USE NATURAL GAS?



The addition of a natural gas generator means that the inconvenience of load-shedding is no longer an issue.

Piped natural gas business uses include steam generation, combined heat and cooling generation, and power generation. It is also used extensively for numerous manufacturing processes.

The wide spectrum of natural gas uses ensures its longevity as a highly efficient and cost-effective energy solution for industrial and manufacturing use.

Egoli Gas reticulates natural gas directly to customers' premises within the Greater Johannesburg area via an established and safe 1,200-kilometre piped natural gas network. Johannesburg is currently the only South African city with reticulated piped natural gas.

Natural gas is piped by Sasol from Mozambique to Secunda via an 864-kilometre pipeline. From Secunda the pressure is reduced and the natural gas is odorised, entering the Gauteng network at Nigel. Methane-rich gas is produced in Secunda. It is then piped to Richards Bay and down to Durban South.
